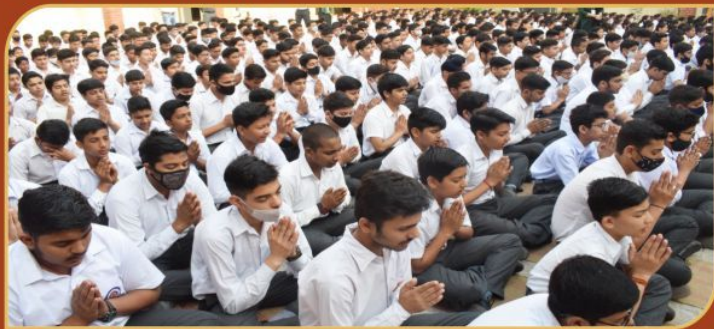

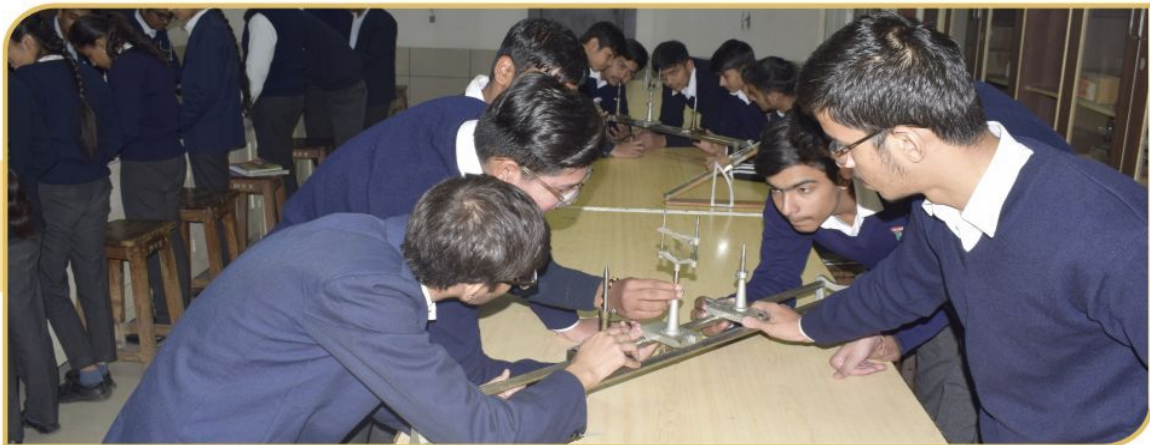

# ADMISSION & WITHDRAWAL RULES

1. The school opens for admission in the first week of April every year, though registration for admission starts in the month of February. Prospectus & Registration forms are available at the school counter on payment of ₹ 300/- only.
2. Children of age above 3½ years to L.K.G. Class. To this effect birth certificate issued by the Municipal Committee in original is to be submitted along with Aadhaar Card.
3. Registration does not mean guarantee of admission. The admission is granted after admission test & personal interview with the child before admission committee.
4. The guardian must deposit the admission form, 3 Passport size photos, report card of previous class, previous school leaving certificate, family ID, Aadhaar Card of parents and student and certificate regarding date of birth at the time of admission of the child. Admission is confirmed only after fulfilling all the above mentioned conditions.
5. In case a student leaves the school for such compulsion as transfer of parents or for health reason before completion of the session, pro-rata return of deposited fee would be refunded.
6. Delinquent children or problematic students who do not improve after two warnings will be discontinued and no re-admission is accorded in any case.
7. A student appearing for AISSE X class Board Exam from this school will be granted provisional admission to class XI in April beginning & his/her subjects/stream will be decided as per merit list to be drawn on the basis of the performance in the house tests/exams throughout the year including Pre-board Examination. The admission will be finalised only if one passes in all the subjects in the Board Examination.
8. In case of availability of seats, provisional admission to class XI for an outsider will be made purely on merit basis in the Written Admission Test to be conducted by the school. It is clearly stated that it will be merely provisional admission which will be confirmed only after the declaration of the Board Examination result, passing in all the subjects.
9. New academic session will start from 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2023 except Class XI.
10. Except the case of transfer from other cities, admission is not usually made in classes X & XII. Transfer cases are recommended only if the number of students is less than the optimum limit in a section.

## FEE RULES FOR THE SESSION 2023-24

1. The school fee will be charged quarterly.  
There will be four quarters.  
(a) First quarter : April to June (b) Second quarter : July to Sep  
(c) Third quarter : Oct to Dec (d) Fourth quarter : Jan to March
2. The due date for quarterly fee submission is upto the 15<sup>th</sup> of the quarter month. In case it is a holiday on 15<sup>th</sup> then the next date will be considered for the same.  
A surcharge will be applicable on late fee  
(From 15<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> of quarter month (April, July, Oct, Jan) = ₹ 20/-)  
(From 21<sup>st</sup> to last date of the quarter month (April, July, Oct, Jan) = ₹ 50/-)

3. The name of the child will be struck off the rolls on the last day of the first quarter month in case the fee remains outstanding.
4. Re-admission fee ₹ 500/- will be charged if admitted within 15 days after the name had been struck off. After that ₹ 2000/- will be charged for re- admission.
5. Concession Criteria:  
Case 1-Sibling concession: ₹ 500/- per month  
Case 2-Fatherless students will be given 50% concession only in tuition fee.
6. Students admitted under the scheme of 134-A will only be considered for 134-A scheme concession from the date of admission in the school. The deposited Infrastructure Maintenance/Facilitation Charges/ Operational Expenses and tuition fee are applicable before enrolment under 134-A scheme in the school and will not be adjusted or refunded in any condition. It is also to be noted that enrolled students under 134- A scheme must submit fee related to CBSE, van fee or any other fee as per school rules.
7. The old students must submit their fee for the next class with in 15 days from the date of commencement of the session.
8. There will be no 'refund' of prospectus - cum- registration fee for admission in any case. The admission can also be refused on unsatisfactory report of the child as reflected by the certificate of School Based Evaluation/ School Leaving Certificate issued by the previous school.

**Transportation Rules :**

- i) No student can leave the bus facility in the month of May, February & March.
- ii) Van facility in rural areas is possible if students are 10 or more than 10. (Subject to availability of school van.)

## ////////// ATTENDANCE & LEAVE RULES //////////

1. Every student must complete 80% of school attendance to appear in the Annual Examination. In a very rare and genuine case shortage of only 5% attendance is consolable by the Principal.
2. Attendance of every student is compulsory in morning assembly.
3. Every student must be present at the time of roll call in the classroom.
4. Absence for any session of a day without any leave application means a fine of one rupee and name will be struck off the rolls after continuous absence for six days.
5. Attendance in school functions, co-curricular activities, evening games, extra classes is equally compulsory and same norms are applicable for all activities of the school.
6. No leave application will be entertained if it is not properly endorsed by the parents or authorised guardian.
7. For Board classes (X, XII), less than 75% attendance makes a student ineligible for appearing in the exam. The School principal has no discretion to condone the required limit, he can only recommend such cases to the Chairman, C.B.S.E. for condonation. Rules laid down by the Board in this regard are final.

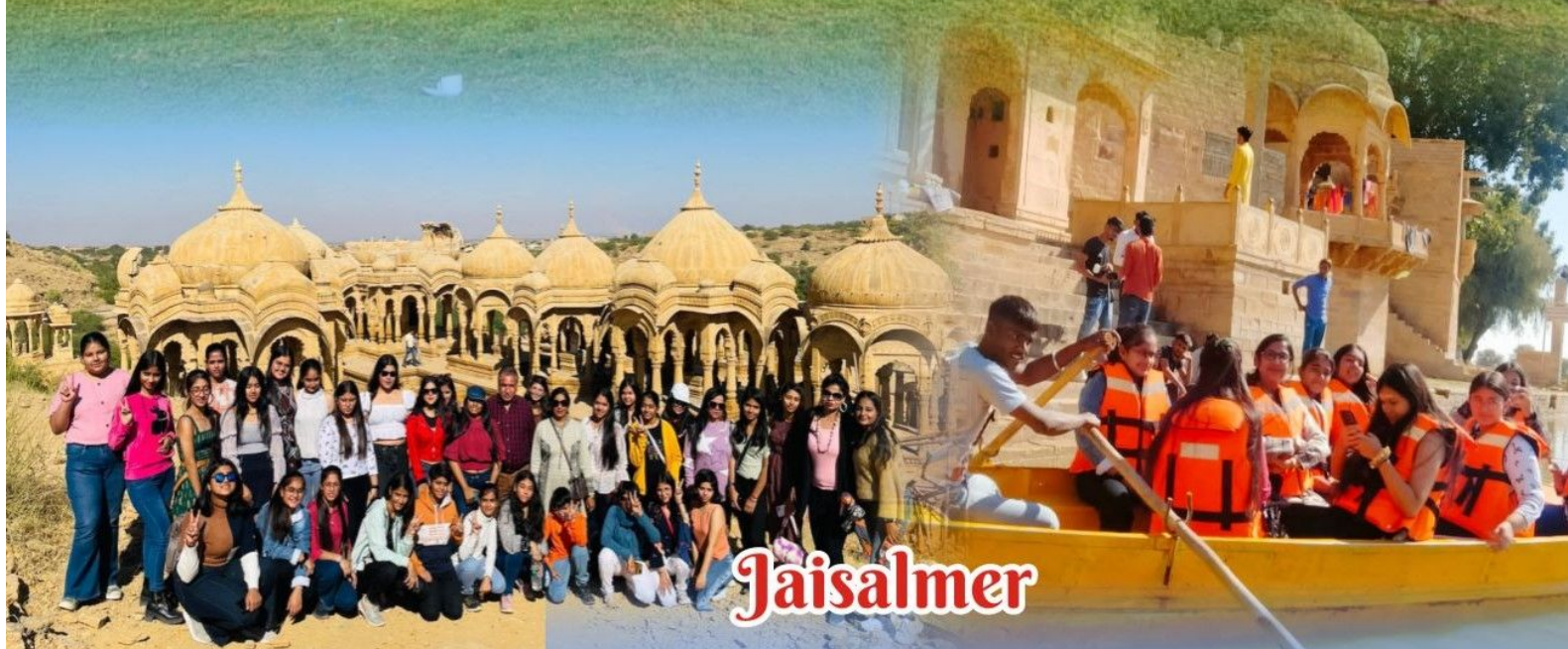
